O desenvolvimento teórico da Ciência Política e seus desdobramentos na área de Relações Internacionais. OBJETIVOS

A disciplina pretende abordar perspectivas teóricas e analíticas que permitem compreender as crises da ordem internacional liberal relacionadas a quatro problemas fundamentais: a natureza dos conflitos internacionais no pós-Guerra Fria e as dificuldades do atual sistema de segurança coletiva; a natureza complexa dos problemas que demandam a intervenção das organizações internacionais, como os temas de saúde global, de meio ambiente e de segurança internacional; as crises e impasses dos atuais processos de integração regional do Mercosul e da União Europeia; e os problemas da democracia no âmbito do Estado e da política internacional que contribuem para as crises da ordem internacional contemporânea. O primeiro objetivo da disciplina é caracterizar essas crises. O segundo objetivo é examinar as perspectivas teóricas e analíticas que podem contribuir para analisar o quadro contemporâneo. Essas perspectivas estão distribuídas em quatro diferentes temáticas: Atores transnacionais e a sociedade civil global; As abordagens teóricas de regimes e organizações internacionais; As teorias contemporâneas de Segurança Internacional e de Integração Regional; e a subárea de Análise de Política Externa.

UNIDADE III – Abordagens teóricas de regimes e organizações internacionais.




AVALIAÇÃO






