EMENTA

This proposal seeks to investigate and analyze the diverse public and private policies implemented by major countries in the Global South to support alternative forms of innovation. The motivation behind studying alternative innovation arises from concerns raised during significant events such as the global financial crisis and, more recently, the COVID-19 pandemic. Even prior to the emergence of COVID-19, issues such as environmental crises, institutional collapses, middle-income traps, stagflation, and wealth inequalities resulting from the 2008 recession had already sparked apprehensions regarding innovation and growth models in developed nations.

The four sessions comprise the following aspects:

- Session One (04/12): Innovation and Development: Perspectives from the Economic History of Nations
- Session Two (06/12): Alternative Innovation Models: Insights from the Global South
- Session Three (11/12): Navigating the Innovation Landscapes: A Comparative Analysis of India and China
- Session Four (13/12): Frugal Future: Lessons from China and Indian innovation systems

The workshop will be conducted in English.
